

**ORDER OF CONTINUATION AND RENEWAL OF SCURRY COUNTY  
DISASTER DECLARATION SIGNED ON MARCH 16, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Scurry County Judge Executed a Declaration of Disaster for Scurry County on March 16, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner's Court of Scurry County has determined that imminent threat to Public Health is still present due to the COVID-19 virus; and

**WHEREAS**, the Declaration signed by the Scurry County Judge was effective for seven (7) days after the Execution thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Scurry County Commissioner's Court has determined that measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of the people and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout Scurry County, including the quarantine of individuals, groups of individuals, property and, additionally, compelling individuals, groups of individuals, or property to undergo additional Health Measures that prevent or control the spread of disease.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND PROCLAIMED BY THE SCURRY COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT:**

1. That the local State of Disaster, proclaimed by the Scurry County Judge on March 16, 2020 and continued and renewed through April 14, 2020 and renewed again through May 14, 2020 and is still in effect Pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.


2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the prior Declaration is hereby continued and renewed through June 14, 2020, unless terminated earlier by a vote of the Scurry County Commissioner's Court.



4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this Renewal and Continuation Order activates the **Scurry County Emergency Management Plan**.
