With a sad heart I regret to have to inform the public that our office will temporarily cease the acceptance of passport applications due to the COVID-19 outbreak. In accordance with the precautions Governor Greg Abbott and the CDC have recommended this is what I feel is appropriate for the health of the citizens of Scurry County and the for the staff members of my office.

This is a temporary situation and we will resume acceptance and processing of passport applications as soon as possible after the State of Emergency has been lifted state wide by Governor Abbot and locally by our Commissioner's Court.

I do apologize in advance for this unforeseen inconvenience as I am well aware of the issues this could possibly cause for the individual who is need of this service.

Our office has chosen to provide this service to our county in hopes that eases the burden of acquiring a passport. I'd like to reiterate one more time that we will resume this process as soon as possible.

We will cease accepting applications on Friday, March, 16, 2020, at 4:30 p.m. and will resume as soon as possible. If you have questions, please call us at 325-573-5641.
