

Statements required in notice if the proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate but does not exceed the voter-approval tax rate, as prescribed by Tax Code §§26.06(b-2).

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

This notice only applies to a taxing unit other than a special taxing unit or municipality with a population of less than 30,000, regardless of whether it is a special taxing unit.

PROPOSED TAX RATE: \$0.6600 per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE: \$0.7784 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE: \$0.8617 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Scurry County from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Scurry County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Scurry County is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON 08/18/2026 10:00 AM (CT) at Scurry County Court Room 3rd Floor, 1806 25th Street, Snyder, TX

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Scurry County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Scurry County of Scurry County at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

No-New-Revenue Maintenance and Operations Rate Adjustments

State Criminal Justice Mandate (counties)

The Scurry County Auditor certifies that Scurry County has spent \$1,251,426 in the previous 12 months for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Scurry County Sheriff has provided Scurry County information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for the reimbursement of such costs. This increased the no-

new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.0248 /\$100.

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures (counties)

The Scurry County spent \$267,767 from July 1 2025 to June 30 2026 on indigent health care compensation procedures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$25,428. (amount of increase) This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.0010 /\$100.

Indigent Defense Compensation Expenditures (counties)

The Scurry County spent \$243,951 from July 1 2025 to June 30 2026 to provide appointed counsel for indigent individuals in criminal or civil proceedings in accordance with the schedule of fees adopted under Article 26.05, Code of Criminal Procedure, less the amount of any state grants received. For current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent defense compensation expenditures is \$3,413. This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.0001/\$100.
